GENERAL INFORMATION



Dear students, welcome to the Design for Social innovation summer school workshop!

The workshop will be held in Gioia Sannitica on **Oct. 4–5–6–7**, and, in addition to these four days of fieldwork, there will be **two more days of classroom work** and one day of presentation to institutions afterwards, which will be held in Naples at the Department of Architecture, University of Naples Federico II. The dates for the two days following the site immersion period and that of the final presentation will be revealed soon.

Transportation:

On the morning of the **4th of October** we will leave together by bus from Naples to Gioia Sannitica. The departure will be in the morning around 8:00 am. On **October 7** we will leave together to return by bus from Gioia Sannitica to Naples. The return will be in the afternoon with arrival in Naples in the evening. We will soon notify you of the exact location and address of departures and arrivals.

During the 4-day workshop we will visit some **significant places** that will help you in the development of the project, meeting the **communities** and trying to have an **immersive experience** of the places.

Travel from the places where you will stay overnight or work to the sites visited will be provided by **tour buses**, with some walking for visits with the help of local guides.

The cost of transportation and visits will be met by the organization.

Overnight stay:

Accommodation will be divided into **4 different structures**.

We ask you to divide yourselves into the different arrangements by putting your names in the room slots. We ask you to handle this phase of the organization independently.

These are **family-run structures**, which will allow you to get in touch with the social dimension of the area.

The cost of overnight stay is met by the organization.

Food:

Breakfast will be eaten in the individual accommodation. **Lunch** will be a packed snack that we will consume in the spaces where the workshop will take place.

***Please note: All participants must bring a PACKED LUNCH and WATER with them on the on the 4th of October. Lunch will NOT be provided in Gioia Sannitica and it will NOT be possible to buy lunch there.**

Dinner will be all together, in different restaurants in the area.

Costs of lunches and dinners are the responsibility of the organization.

Clothing:

Bring **comfortable shoes** for the visits. We will be in high hill country: at times the weather may be colder: bring something **warm** and something **waterproof!**

Equipment:

We will equip a space to work with work tables, projection screens, electrical outlets, wi-fi.

You will need to bring your usual working tools with you: laptop, tablet, camera, sketch pads, and handwriting and drawing materials.

Organization of activities:

The work will be done in **groups** that will be formed before the workshop starts, respecting the principle of internationality of the DBE, and will be communicated to you shortly.

Activity locations:

Design activities and workshops will be held at a facility located in the municipality of Gioia Sannitica.

The visit and interaction activities with the inhabitants will include part of the **Alto Casertano** and **Sannio** territories that fall within the **Mount Matese** area between the provinces of Benevento and Caserta. In particular, in addition to Gioia Sannitica, the area of Cerreto Sannita, Cusano Mutri, Bocca della Selva, Lago del Matese, Letino.
